## SIX MILLION JEWS



We light the 1st candle in memory of the helpless infants, children, and teenagers cut down like young trees before their time.

**YIZKOR... YOU ARE NOT FORGOTTEN**

We light the 2nd candle in memory of the mothers who died with their children in their arms.

**YIZKOR... YOU ARE NOT FORGOTTEN**

We light the 3rd candle in memory of the fathers and mothers cruelly separated from their families

**YIZKOR... YOU ARE NOT FORGOTTEN**

We light the 4th candle in memory of the political activists, scholars, teachers, and clergy who were the first to be taken.

**YIZKOR... YOU ARE NOT FORGOTTEN**

We light the 5th candle in memory of the Jewish men and women who fled to the forests and who lived to fight the Nazis.

**YIZKOR... YOU ARE NOT FORGOTTEN**

We light the 6th candle in memory of the martyrs whose lives were given that others might live.
